### ***Power In Weakness***

In 2 Corinthians Paul deals with a church struggling with both their own sin and their relationship with him. This complex letter is very affirming, yet at the same time is full of warnings.

In this most autobiographical letter of Paul, we encounter Paul's deep commitment to defending his walk with Jesus. Paul had invested everything in walking with Jesus, even suffering in the "Jesus tradition."

Paul's ministry was not a picture of success by worldly terms. He encountered trouble and challenges at every turn. Paul explains his ministry was not to be judged by worldly standards and that power is best seen in his weakness.

Paul presents the story of the cross as a dynamic resource for living a life of righteousness, peace, and generosity in your community of faith.
