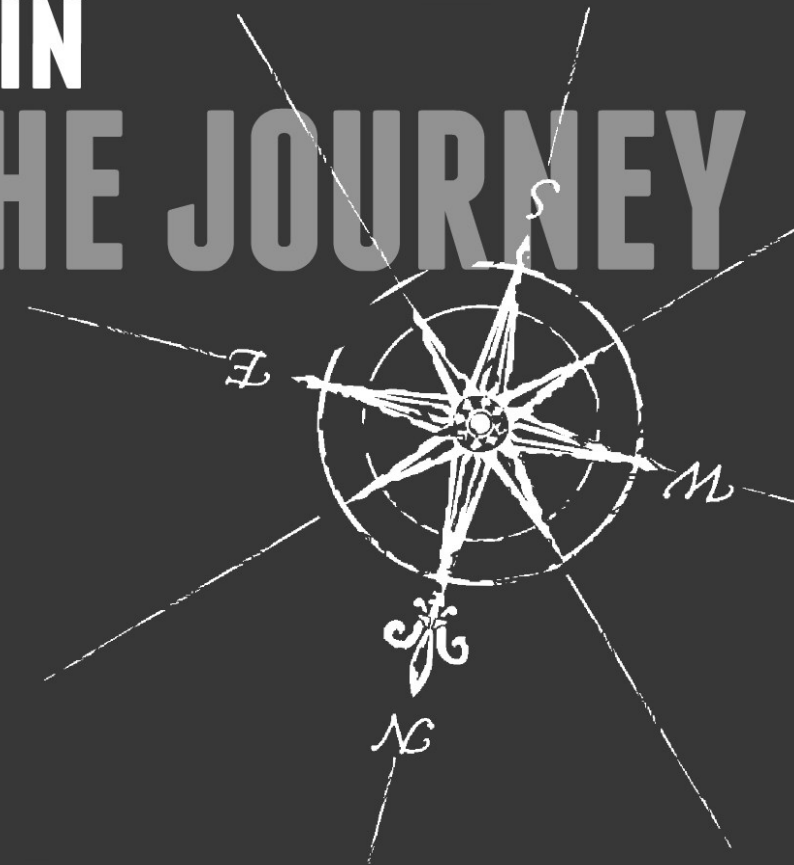
Infant toys, diaper bags, receiving blankets, burp cloths, bibs, all types of new and gently used baby clothing. **(Place in drive-thru lobby.)**

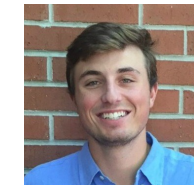

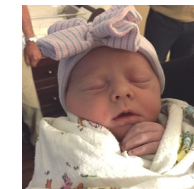
College Minister
